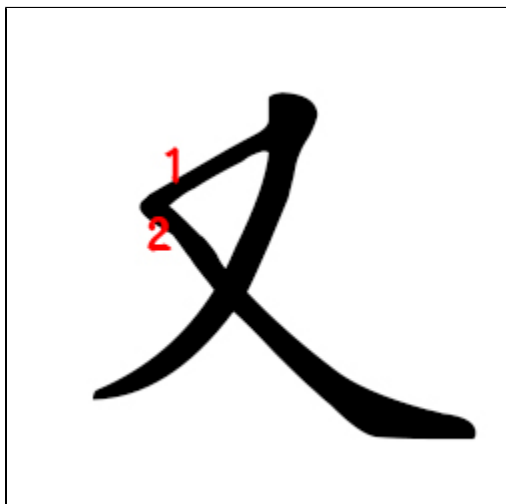


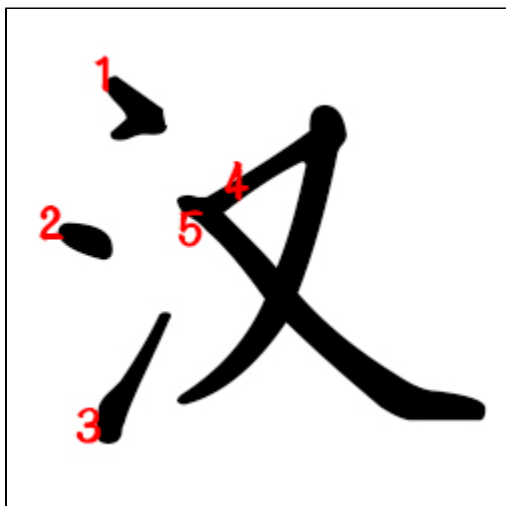
3Again

In the following three characters it replaces what was traditionally a more complex element:

Hàn is 'Han (Chinese)':

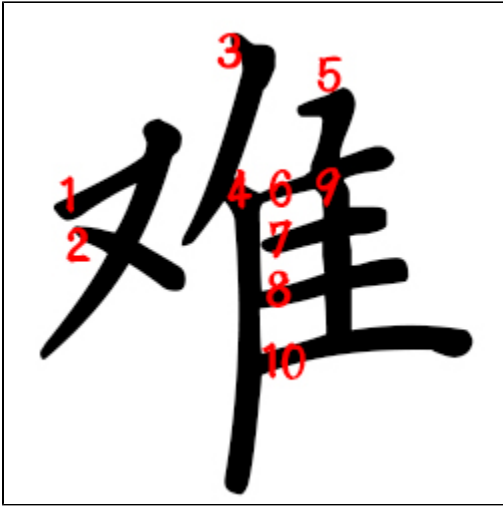


Common word: hànzi 'Chinese character'
