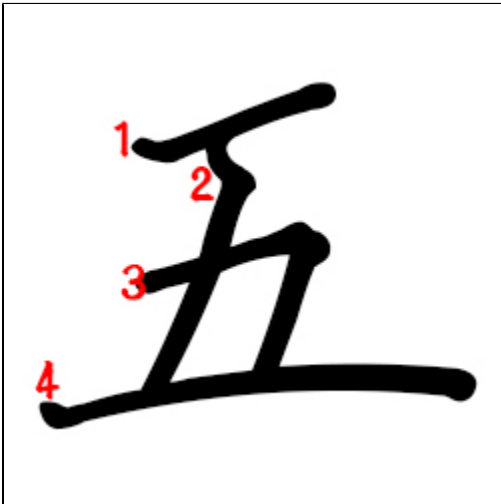


### 3Five
