

How to turn on/off anonymous permissions for a space

Anonymous permissions allow a wiki space to be viewable by the public without the need to login. *Please note that only space admins can use this functionality*

Global Spaces/Personal Spaces

1. Navigate to your global space by clicking space on the top menu > space directory and search for your space . For personal spaces click on your profile icon > personal space.
2. Once on your space, at the bottom on the left hand menu click space tools > permissions.

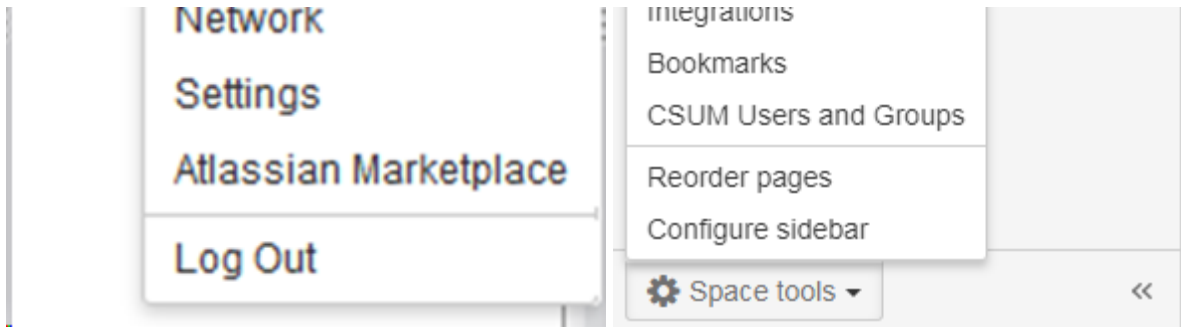
