Dòng is often used with verbs of motion.

### Pádedòng 'can climb'

Zhè zuò shān bù duǎ, wǒmen pádedòng.  
'This hill isn't steep; we can climb it.'

Jǐrán dào le Chángchéng, zài lèi yì di pádedòng.  
'If you are already on the Great Wall, you should climb hard even if you get more tired.'

Kuài dào shàng le, nǐ hái pádedòng ma?  
'We are nearly there on the hill top, can you still climb?'

Dài zhème zhòng de xíng, zǎi nǐ néng pádedòng?  
'How could you climb (the stairs), carrying such heavy luggage?'

Tā zhège niánjì hái pádedòng lóu.  
'She is able to climb stairs even at her age.'
