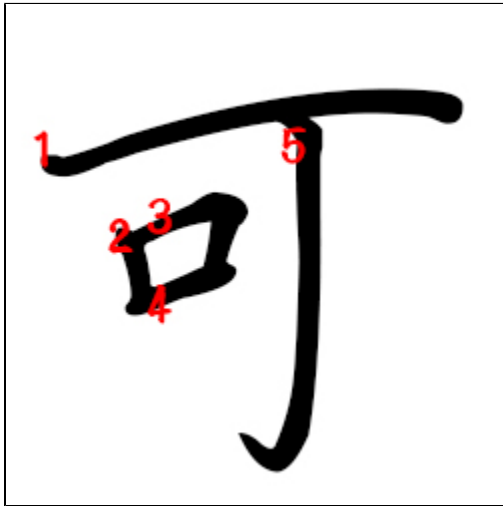


3Ke-ge

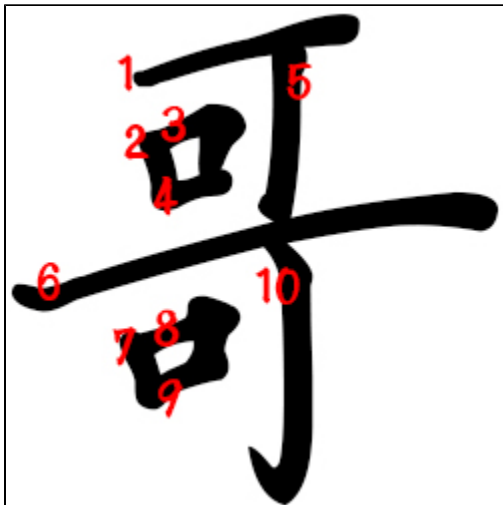
K means 'OK, all right'.



Think of the square as a circle meaning 'OK'. (Curves generally get squared off as in ku 'mouth' and r 'ear'.)

Common words: ky 'can', kài 'cute'

Common word: gge 'elder brother'
