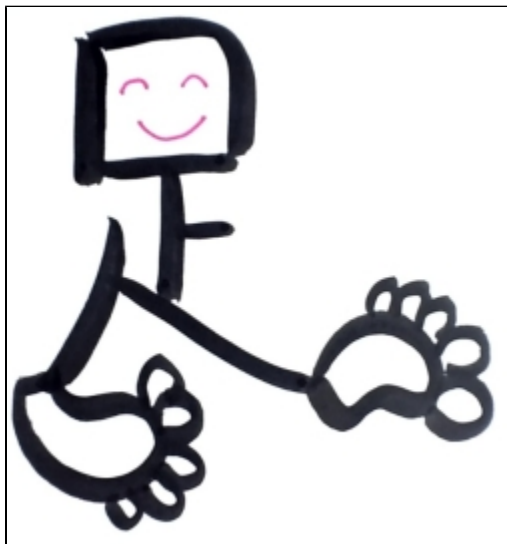


3Feet

Zú means 'foot'

in words like zúqiú 'soccer'.

Jiǎo is more common for 'foot' outside compounds in modern Mandarin.



You will also see this character meaning 'enough' in words such as bùzú 'insufficient'. What can the connection between feet and enough be?

Pǎo is 'run'. The sound comes from bō 'wrap'.

Lù is 'road'. The sound does not come from gè 'each'!
