For measuring liquid etc. contained in bottles, vases, and jars

yì píng shu 'a bottle of water'

yì píng hu 'a bottle full of flowers'

yì píng gujiàng 'a jar of jam'

Nà píng shu cóng t de shushàng huáluò.
'The bottle of water slipped from her hand.'

T dkile nà píng Yìndù mòshu.
'She opened the bottle of Indian ink.'

W yu líng píng wíshìjī.
'I have two bottles of whisky.'

N kǎ zài zhūshàng fàng j píng xīnhu.
'You can put several vases of fresh flowers on the table.'

T xūn b bōzhūngzh bōcún zài píngzi l.
'She likes to keep wrappers in a jar.'

Zhè zhǒng píngzi yu ge dà kǒu, yúshíhòu hái yu líng ge bāshu.
'This kind of jar has a wide mouth and sometimes has two handles.'
