Què is 'however, on the other hand'



Here's an example from [The Buddha statue and the stone steps](#):

Wèishénme w mi tin shòudào rénmen de jiàntà, n què néng shòudào dāji de móbài ne?
Why have I been trampled on *and yet* you have been worshipped by people every day?

Qiè is 'timid'



The element on the left is a form of 心 'heart', indicating an emotion.

F is 'method' or 'French'



The element on the left is a form of 水 'water, if that helps!
Common words: fǎng 'method', Fǎguó 'France'
